

## Sixth Form Reconnection Funding 2020-2021

To enable schools to address the impact of Covid-19, and to revisit, strengthen and consolidate students' learning, the government has provided extra funding for the current academic year. Some of the funding has been ring-fenced to support tuition for 16 to 19 students who had not achieved grade 5 or above in GCSE maths and / or GCSE English by the age of 16. This is referred to as the **16 to 19 tuition fund**.

The table below is taken from the wider Academy Reconnection plan and details how the 16 to 19 tuition fund is being used during academic year 2020/2021 to support our sixth form students who fall into the abovementioned category. NB - The table only reflects initiatives where a cost is involved, Forge has numerous other strategies and initiatives currently in place where no costs are involved.
