WHAT CAN YOU DO? PUNCTUALITY

At Ormiston Forge Academy, students are expected to arrive on site no later than 08.30 and to be in their AM period ready for its start at 08.35.

Any student arriving after 08.35 is LATE and must sign in electronically at main reception

Punctuality is a life skill and habit best mastered at a young age. Being punctual sets you up psychologically for the day ahead and indicates to others that you are invested in your education.

Students arriving late to the academy after **08.35** will receive a same day B2 - 20 Minute Detention (Late to school) on each occasion they are late.

Students arriving late to the academy after **08.55** will receive a same day B3 - 60 Minute Detention (Late after form) on each occasion they are late.

We are relentless in the pursuit of achieving outstanding punctuality for all of our students and expect our families to support us with. this.

REMARDS FOR ATTENDANCE

Our attendance rewards program is designed to motivate and recognise your commitment to attending school. We want to make sure that every student has the chance to earn recognition for their attendance throughout the year.

The program works in six half-term cycles, giving students six opportunities to earn fantastic rewards for achieving excellent or improving attendance.

We understand how important it is to recognise student dedication, resilience and efforts and so in addition to the six half termly rewards students will be in receipt of Forge points for achieving their weekly attendance targets

Our attendance reward system is here to help students feel proud of their attendance and motivated to keep doing their best.

REPORTING ABSENCE

At Ormiston Forge Academy, all absences must be reported by 9am on each day of absence stating the reason

Medical evidence may also be requested to authorise absences, particularly where there are on-going attendance concerns. Without this, absences may be recorded as unauthorised.



Where possible, we encourage all medical appointments to be kept outside school hours.

Where this is not possible students must come into school with evidence of the appointment, sign out and then return back to school after the appointment. A full day will not be authorised for routine medical appointments at the GP, dentist etc.

We firmly believe that excellent attendance is vital for fostering both the happiness and academic achievements of our students. As such, we make no apology for upholding high expectations for attendance. We aspire to a **100%** attendance rate from all our students, setting a minimum attendance target of 97%.

Much of our attendance policy is designed to satisfy DfE regulations but as always, if you feel an approach is unfair or unreasonable, then you can write to the Principal and/or Governing Body asking for a review. However, whilst any such policy is in place, the academy will operate as stated.
