### Core Subjects:

In years Key Stage 3, students will receive regular maths quizzes via Sparx maths, science quizzes, MFL vocabulary, and reading activities from English.



### Vocabulary:

In Key Stage 3 students will have a range of key words to learn for all subjects. The key words are available on the academy website. Students are assessed on their ability to spell the key words and may be asked to learn definitions.



### Deep Learning Projects (DLP):

Each half term, students in Key Stage 3 will be given the opportunity to complete a super-curricular extended deep learning project (DLP) which asks them to look in greater depth at one aspect of a subject. DLP outlines are available on the academy website.

## **Home Learning: 10 and 11**

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### **Prep**

**Students will receive prep homework which requires them to read, research or revise for upcoming lessons.**

**Prep tasks are not marked by a teacher.**

**Prep tasks are designed to make lessons more accessible and to accelerate learning.**

### **Consolidation**

**Consolidation tasks check on learning and allow teachers to plan and deliver material at an appropriate level.**

**Consolidation tasks are marked by a teacher.**

**Consolidation tasks might be quizzes, key words or single examination questions.**

### **Prep and Consolidation Expectations:**

**20 minutes per task. Up to 3 subjects per night. No more than 60 minutes on any day.**
