2. Assessment Dates

- KS3 (Y7 9) Assessment Window Monday 2nd June Friday 27th June
- Y10 Mock Weeks Monday 16th June Monday 30th June
- Year 12 Mock Weeks Monday 9th June Friday 20th June

During this period, we would like to remind you of the importance of good attendance. We kindly ask that any appointments be scheduled outside of core academy hours whenever possible.

3. Free School Meals Allowance (FSM)

We would like to remind you of how the Free School Meal (FSM) allowance works for eligible students.

- Students entitled to FSM currently receive £2.58 per day
- From Monday 16 June, this allowance will only be available to spend **from 12:00pm each day** and can be used at the school canteen tills during lunchtime.
- **Please note:** Any unused allowance **does not roll over** to the next day.





Therefore, if your child wishes to:

- Purchase food during **breaktime**, or
- Spend more than the daily **£2.58** allowance at lunchtime, then their account will need to be **topped up in advance** via ParentPay

If you have any questions or need support with your child's account, please don't hesitate to contact us. A reminder also for students to **bring in a refillable water bottle**. Students have access throughout the day to water. **Energy drinks and fizzy drinks are not allowed on school grounds.**

If you are currently not in receipt of FSM but wish to check your eligibility, please visit <u>Free school</u> <u>meals | Sandwell Council</u>

We would also like to remind you that the school provides a **FREE** breakfast in partnership with Magic Breakfast. This is available from the canteen from 7.30am.

4. Year 11 Prom

The year 11 prom is fast approaching. If your child has not picked up their ticket yet, please remind them to do so as soon as possible from the pastoral office. A reminder that Prom will take place at The Village Hotel. Students can arrive from 6.30pm and the event will finish at 11.00pm.
