4. KS3 Assessment Window - Now Open

The assessment window for Key Stage 3 is now open and will run until **Friday 23rd January**. During this period, students will complete assessments in all subjects. Class teachers will inform students of the specific dates for their assessments.

These assessments are essential for checking progress and ensuring your child is placed in the correct teaching group for the remainder of the academic year. We kindly ask that your child attends the academy every day and that any appointments are scheduled outside core academic hours.

Once all assessments are complete, a **grade report** will be sent home so you can monitor your child's progress. Teachers will also provide feedback and support to help students close any gaps in their knowledge.

5. Free School Meal Vouchers

Families eligible for benefit-related free school meals will receive their supermarket voucher via text message or email on **Monday, 15th December**.
