### **3. Parking and Road Safety**

### **4. ParentPay**

We currently have **132 parents/carers who have not yet set up a ParentPay account for their child**. It is essential that these accounts are created, as we are a completely **cashless site** and ParentPay is used to process payments for items such as school lunches and educational trips. We also collect all consent information for trips through ParentPay.
