4. Appointments, Absences and lateness

Where possible, we kindly ask that medical and other **appointments are arranged outside of core academy hours**. If your child does need to attend an appointment during the school day, please notify the academy in advance.

We have recently had several parents and carers arriving to collect their child during lunchtime without prior notice. Please be aware that **during the school lunch period, we are unable to locate students** due to the number of pupils who are around site participating in lunchtime activities. By notifying us in advance, we can update our systems accordingly and ensure your child is prepared for collection or leaves the academy at the appropriate time.

5. Detentions

Behaviour Detentions: If your child is issued with a behaviour detention, this will be **set and served on the same day**. If they receive **two 20minute detentions** in one day, this will automatically result in a **one hour detention**.

Homework Detentions: If your child does not complete their homework, they will receive a **B1** and be given an additional **24 hours** to complete the work. If the homework is still not completed after this time, a **20-minute detention** will be issued and must be served **on the same day** the extended deadline ends. **Parents and carers can view B1 marks through their child's ClassCharts account.**

Reflection: Students placed in Reflection will also be required to remain in school for an **additional hour after the end of the school day** as part of the sanction.

Failure to attend a detention will lead to the sanction being automatically escalated. If you need to discuss any details surrounding your child's detention, please contact a member of their **Year Team** by:
